

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## Strong contender: Ford Ranger Single Cab 3.2-litre Duratorq TDCi

Emissions are measured at 245g/100km on both the 4x2 and 4x4 models. Move over Toyota Hilux, there is a new king on the reigns with more to offer.

The Ranger also offers notable towing capabilities with the 4x4 model able to tow up to 3 350kg when fitted with the range topping diesel engine. For farmers and logistic business owners, this will save you time as you can ferry spare parts and tyres without a glitch. Both derivatives can achieve a maximum of 800 millimetres wade depth level while maintaining a steady speed of not more than 7km per hour. For more information and guidelines on driving through water please refer to the Ranger Owners' Manual before attempting such driving conditions. Also your dealer will assist with driver training which will give you more insight. Don't go swimming in small rivers in your Ranger without the right information.

The high belt-line and raised rails of the load box ensure a load box volume of 1.82 cubic metres. Pockets above the wheel wells and along the side of the box allow owners to use timber inserts to carry full sheets of plasterboard or plywood.

The Ranger has been designed to cater to a wide spectrum of customers. Both fleet buyers and small business owners will now be able to take advantage of the greater selection of models on offer while enjoying the quality, fuel efficiency, safety and smart technology that have made the Ranger such a popular choice with most Zimbabweans. Additionally, Ranger 4x4 customers receive free off-road driver training which allows the owners and fleet managers to better understand the vehicle. Remember you cannot fully enjoy something when you do not have adequate knowledge or training.

# The GLC Coupe from Mercedes

N this issue we lead with a vehicle brand which has evolved over the years. It has transitioned and has certainly cemented its mark across all segments. One vehicle which drives through the pages in this issue of the Motor Trend is the new GLC Coupé.

This new kid on the block full of iconic models makes quite an impression as the sports car among the Mercedes Benz SUVs. A standard-fit sports suspension as well as more direct sports steering, dynamic select and 4MATIC permanent all-wheel drive with 9G-TRONIC nine-speed automatic transmission combine effortlessly superior ride comfort with decidedly sporty agility.

When I had a chat about the new additions with Louissa Crossley Evans I could not help it but be captivated by this young woman knowledge and love of the brand.

She took me step by step on what they at Zimoco have achieved over the years and the product offering that has seen the light and rewritten the history of the brand with the many success stories. The GLC on the other hand is set to not only turn heads but strongly compete for its rightful position as an all round contender, 100 percent SUV & 100 percent Sports car.

The GLC comes with optional two suspension variants with continuously adjustable damping: the new dynamic body control with steel springing as well as the air body control multi-chamber air suspension. The distinct sportiness and dynamism is enriched with the high safety and state-of-the-art assistance systems so characteristic of the brand.

The combination of multifunctional SUV and dynamic coupé world neatly fuses emotion with intelligence.

With an exterior length of 4,73 metres, a height of 1.60 metres and a wheelbase of 2,87 metres, the GLC Coupé is dynamic and compact in appearance. This makes the coupé almost eight centimetres longer and some four centimetres lower than the multi-talented GLC, with which it shares its basic architecture. The GLC Coupé owes its distinct character to a characteristically coupé-esque, single-louvred diamond radiator grille and a restyled, dropping roof-line. The A pillar is less steeply raked, while the continuation of the roof outline is lower, terminating in the elegantly flowing, muscular tail end characteristic of a coupé.

The striking features of the front end are its dominant, steeply raked diamond radiator grille with a single louvre and integral star, short overhang and SUV inspired chromed underquard.

The innovative headlamp concept, optionally in LED High Performance technology, sports the now characteristic Mercedes-Benz light signature. A striking injection of sports car genes is provided by the large lateral air inlets.

A clear clue to the vehicle's distinctive SUV heritage is given by the optionally available side running boards. Flush with the outer edge of the body, wide wheels up to a size of 50,8 centimetres (20 inches) together with ample ground clearance underpin the GLC Coupé's sporty, dynamic ambitions on unpaved tracks and unsurfaced roads.

The styling of the tail end gives added emphasis to the vehicle's coupé genes. With its pronounced shoulders, muscular bumper design with integral exhaust tailpipe trims and underguard in the form of a diffuser, the wide tail end of the GLC Coupé underlines the vehicle's athletic looks. This enables the coupé to hug the road.

Narrow, split tail lights, a centrally positioned brand star and a sharp spoiler lip reflect a design that made its debut with the S-Class Coupé and which all Mercedes-Benz coupé models have since followed. Relocated to the lower section of the bumper, the number plate as well as the characteristic form of the rear window with its rounded upper area, are among the further stylistic features. The rear window dispenses with a wiper, as the airflow does not break away until after the spoiler lip, which means that water is unable to strike the rear window. Like the headlamps, the night design of the LED tail lights sports the hallmark light signature of Mercedes-Benz.

However sporty and aesthetically appealing, the dynamic GLC Coupé also impresses with some practical features too. With a capacity of 491 to 1 400 litres, the load compartment leads this market segment. The availability of space in both front and rear puts the GLC Coupé on a par with the GLC in terms of comfort. Entrance height, shoulder room, elbow room and legroom are all identical.

In keeping with the Mercedes-Benz tradition, the body forms the foundation for exemplary crash safety. A high-strength safety passenger compartment forms the core of this concept. It is surrounded by specifically designed and crash-tested deformation zones, which ensure the best possible occupant safety by virtue of optimised force paths and a combination of diecast aluminium components and ultra-high-strength materials.

In addition to three-point safety belts with pyrotechnical and reversible belt tensioning and belt-force limitation for driver, front passenger and those in the outer rear seats, numerous airbags serve to protect the vehicle's occupants in an accident. These include combined thorax/pelvis side bags for driver and front passenger and an optimised window bag extending over both seat rows, optional side bags for the outer rear seats and a driver knee bag.

Two of KIA Motor Corporation's efficient Kappa engines do duty in the all-awesome Picanto, starting with three-cylinder, 998 cc unit producing 51 kW and 94 Nm of torque in the 1.0 LX. A four-cylinder,

1248 cc engine is utilized in the range-topping 1.2 EX, producing 65 kW and 120 Nm of torque. Both engines are mated to a five-speed manual transmission, but a four-speed automatic transmission is available as an option.

This combination of technologies has resulted in significantly reduced exhaust emissions, while allowing the Picanto range fuel excellent economy.

The Picanto's high quality interior has reflected the range's newfound maturity since its debut in 2011, and this remains one of the Picanto's major selling points. Major controls are arranged in an attractive, easy to use layout, while the thick rimmed, uniquely designed, two-spoke steering wheel and the signature Kia 'three cylinder' instrument cluster continues to reflect the consistency with which Kia's new design philosophy is being used throughout the brand's product line-up.

Features available on both models include manual air-conditioning, an under-floor trunk storage box, retractable dual cup holders and sun visors with vanity mirrors, as well as AUX/iPod/USB connections for the radio CD player with MP3 compatibility (the EX also sports steering wheel mounted controls and handsfree Bluetooth. You can talk on the phone and drive without worrying about our boys in grey.

The 1.0 LX and 1.2 EX boasts driver and passenger airbags. ABS anti-lock braking is standard on the 1.2 EX, as is an ESS (Emergency Stop Signal) system. Sensors detect when the driver is braking suddenly and hard, and then flash the brake lights three times to alert motorists behind you that the car is slowing rapidly.

If a spare part costs 90 percent less than the branded and boxed original manufacturer's part, there is a reason for this. Don't let a moment of joy at a parts counter translate into hours stuck on the road in the middle of nowhere.

Branded parts, as well as those carrying Standard Association of Zimbabwe's ratings, are guarantees of quality. At the very least you won't be replacing parts as often as you would be if you bought parts with a lower life expectancy.

#### 4. Remember that peace of mind comes with physical dealer presence:

Finding yourself stuck on the side of the road with the nearest dealer 250 kilometres or more away could ruin your day and also improve the financial prospects of a tow-truck driver.



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## Sporty crossover with Kia Sportage

## Cleaning your car interior

LIKE many areas of car care and auto detailing, how to clean car upholstery is an area filled with so many different opinions and strategies that many people like yourself feel overwhelmed at the very thought.

Over the weekend I had the opportunity to DIY my own fabric upholstered vehicle interior with a local product which I was given as a sample by sofaman.

For many of us day after day goes by and the only attention your car's upholstery ever gets in the best of circumstances is a quick vacuum job. But vacuuming your cars upholstery is only going to go so far in removing dirt that will accumulate within your car's interior. Eventually you will need to find some form of upholstery cleaner, get personal with the interior of your car and do some scrubbing to remove grime, grease and tough spots.

When I looked at the interior of my vehicle, I noticed that the various materials and surfaces

that made up the interior of my vehicle were stained and covered in dirt. Upon first glance, the idea of cleaning the upholstery within my car or any car can be overwhelming. Despite my fears and anxiety, cleaning the inside of my car with the sofaman shampoo was far easier and simpler to do. For a nice aroma, I used the Lavender though it's also available in pot pourri, summer fragrance and green rose fragrance.

With the shampoo, there was no need for hot water carpet extractors, high pressure water systems or other complicated methods. I just used a bit of luke warm water plus the shampoo and a soft brush do all interior surfaces, roof, seats and carpets with ease.

This shampoo thoroughly cleaned the carpeting, cloth and velour fabrics, my vinyl and rubber sections in the car, and all my plastic lined interiors and seats leaving them as good as new.

A common misconception when cleaning any kind of upholstery is that the more water used, the better the result. This could not be further from the truth as more water does not necessarily mean more effective stain removal. This I noticed as I used the sofaman shampoo which does not require the use on gallons or buckets of water.

Just a little water to create the right amount of form and lather to clean up surfaces. Moisture is extremely bad for the fabric, and can damage the fabric as well as leave the interior of the car with a dump or musty smell. Another point to note is to avoid getting water on any metal portion of the seat such as zippers. This can lead to rust, and more stains to deal with in the future. With these two important points in mind, you will remember the next time you buy a shampoo and embark on a DIY exercise at home.
